DIVERSITY SCHOLARSHIP (\$2,500 TO \$5,000)

- Accepted to an ISA or TEAN **semester** OR **summer** study abroad program OR applicable 8+ week Internship or Service-Learning program.

SEMESTER PARTNERSHIP SCHOLARSHIP (\$2,000)

- Accepted to an ISA or TEAN **semester** study abroad program OR an applicable 8-week Internship or Service-Learning program.
- Attend an ISA or TEAN-affiliated university. See our list of [Affiliated Universities](#) for more information.
- On financial aid. The [Budget and Funding](#) form must be submitted with this completed scholarship application.
- 3.0+ cumulative GPA required.

SUMMER PATHWAYS SCHOLARSHIP (\$1,000)

- Accepted to an ISA or TEAN **summer** study abroad program OR an applicable Internship or Service-Learning program.
- On financial aid. The [Budget and Funding](#) form must be submitted with this completed scholarship application.
- 3.0+ cumulative GPA required.

HOST UNIVERSITY SCHOLARSHIP (award amounts vary)

Any applicants planning to attend these universities that apply for a Diversity or Semester Partnership scholarship will automatically be considered for a university specific scholarship, if available.

GO (Global Opportunity) FULL-RIDE SCHOLARSHIP (up to \$15,000)

The GO Full-Ride Scholarship is designed to give one stand-out **semester** student the opportunity to study abroad. The scholarship can be used for an ISA or TEAN program and covers tuition, program fees and orientation (up to \$15,000 value). There is not a separate application for the GO Full-Ride Scholarship. In order to be considered for this scholarship, applicants must apply and meet the eligibility requirements for the Diversity (semester) or Semester Partnership scholarship by the deadline.

All scholarships are for ISA and TEAN programs only. Students participating in Global Remote Internship, Career Semester, Career Semester Summer Remote, ISA FLEX, WorldStrides Custom Programs, faculty-led or EuroScholars undergraduate research programs are not eligible to apply for these scholarships.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS (in addition to award-specific requirements, these apply to all award types):

- Must be a recent high school graduate or currently enrolled in a college or university at time of planned ISA or TEAN program participation.
- Submit the following as a PDF **by the deadline**. Application materials received after the deadline and/or incomplete applications will not be considered:
 - completed scholarship application (this page)
 - applicable essays
 - Budget and Funding form (if required)
